Inviting such well respected and talented guests each year has afforded a tantalising glimpse of what the sporting future could hold for some of you and we look forward to welcoming another surprise sporting personality to join us this year.

Awards on the evening include a '**Player of the Year**' award in each sport. There will also be an '**Improvement Award**', for an individual who has made the most progress over the season. The winners will each receive an individual trophy from this year's guest speaker. In addition to this, everyone will receive an acknowledgement of his or her enthusiasm and commitment to sport at Park House.

The evening will culminate in the presentation of '**Sports Personality of 2022**'. Two students from each year group will earn this ultimate commendation for their all-round excellence and commitment to sporting achievement in school. Their names will be engraved on the trophy to be presented in subsequent years.

Following the presentations, there will be some light evening supper and drinks, accompanied by a Disco. The dress code will reflect the nature of the evening.
