





Park House School – Site Refurbishment Update:

Greenshaw Learning Trust are undertaking a site wide package of refurbishment works as well as providing a net zero heating solution across a number of buildings at Park House School to improve the learning environment. The works comprise of the following:

• Refurbishment of the building fabric, to include repairs to roofs and elevations across the site.

• Renewal of windows and doors to a number of buildings

• Renewal of hard standings and paving in areas across the site.

• Installation of rainwater harvesting to a number of toilets to reduce water consumption.

• Installation of new air source heat pumps (ASHPs) to a number of buildings and associated works to the electrical infrastructure.

The works to the site commenced during the spring term, with works continuing on site during the summer term, in close co-ordination with the school to reduce disruption to the students.

During the summer holiday period, there will be an increased level of presence on site in order to complete large parts of the works whilst the school is closed to limit the period of disruption.

All contractors have been informed of the period of the day they are permitted to complete noisy working activities and this will be regularly monitored to ensure adherence.

The majority of the work will be completed in the Autumn term.
